Ann Carol Grossman	Class of 1965 – Arts - Created Umbrella Films. Her documentary film "The <i>Powder and the Glory</i> " became the inspiration for the Broadway Musical, "War Paint".
Diana Cataldo	Class of 1958 - Business - Cofounder and Treasurer of Cataldo Ambulance. The company provides 911 services for 18 municipalities and has raised over \$600,000 for the Fight Against Cancer.
Joanne (Assetta) Iovino (Posthumous)	Class of 1964 - Education – Founder of the MHS Alumni Association. English Teacher Malden Public Schools 1968-2005, Initiator of the MHS Hall of Fame Program.
Edmund Trabucco	Class of 1934 - Government – Malden Police Chief. In 1952 he became the youngest lieutenant in the history of Malden Police department, His career in law enforcement spanned 5 decades, Board of Directors Malden YMCA and Malden Red Cross.
Nicholas "Dick" Robinson	Class of 1956 - Media — Broadcasting legend in the 60's and 70's. Opened the Connecticut School of Broadcasting, Responsible for thousands of broadcast careers
Noreen Grice	Class of 1981 - Science - Astronomy Educator. Founder of You Can Do Astronomy,LLC
